Notes for Sam Shmykis:

Pearl Garfinkle's ship manifest lists an uncle from Annopol, "Same Sruyskas," which I assume must be something like Sam Smyskas.

2. ii. David Shmykis. He died in 1907 in Russia. He married Ida Pichenick. She was born in Russia. She died in Russia.

#### **Generation 2**

2. **DAVID**<sup>2</sup> **SHMYKIS** (Isaac<sup>1</sup>). He died in 1907 in Russia. He married **IDA PICHENICK**. She was born in Russia. She died in Russia.

Notes for David Shmykis:

Born around 1870's. The family lived in Annopol, Poland (later Russia, later Ukraine). They were "Litvaks," not belonging to any of the Chassidik sects to the south of Galicia. Together they raised 17 children including 3 sets of twins.

David died when William was thirteen (about 1907).

Notes for Ida Pichenick:

(Ida was also referred to as Chava.) William sent her a ticket to come to the U.S., but she was getting old and felt that she couldn't make the trip.

- 3. i. Rebecca (Breindel)<sup>3</sup> Samuels was born in 1873 in Vilna, Lithuania. She died on 28 Jun 1926 in New York (Manhattan). She married Benjamin (Beryl) Garfinkel.

- V. WILLIAM SAMUELS was born on 15 Aug 1894 in Annopol, Russia (Ukraine). He died on 09 Jan 1966 in Paragould, Arkansas. He married Fannie Sorkin, daughter of Louis Sorkin and Rachel Mampel, on 16 Dec 1916 in U.S.. She was born on 25 Jul 1894 in Moleshkovitch, Russia (Belarus). She died on 22 Jun 1984 in Chesterfield (St. Louis), Mo..
  - vi. Ann Samuels was born on 15 Aug 1894 in Anapola, Russia (Ukraine). She died in Russia.

Notes for Ann Samuels:

William's twin sister. She lived in Russia. Bernard remembers that when he was a child, William got a letter saying she had died in Russia. We know that William had a twin sister, and we believe that he had a sister named Ann; I'm assuming that that was the name of his twin sister.

8. vii. LEAH SAMUELS. She married MOSHE FRUMERMAN.

viii. HERSCHEL SAMUELS.

Notes for Herschel Samuels:

Harry Samuels (whose Hebrew name was Tzvi Hirsh) says he was named after a Harry/Herschel Samuels who was a son of David Samuels. Harry thinks he may have lived in Philadelphia.

#### **Generation 3**

3. **Rebecca** (Breindel)<sup>3</sup> Samuels (David<sup>2</sup> Shmykis, Isaac<sup>1</sup> Shmykis) was born in 1873 in Vilna, Lithuania. She died on 28 Jun 1926 in New York (Manhattan). She married Benjamin (Beryl) Garfinkel.

Notes for Rebecca (Breindel) Samuels:

The 1911 ship manifest lists her as Breindel Garfinkel from Chanopole. 1920 census lists her as Rebecca "Garfunkel," 47, born in "Vilena, Russia." (Might this have meant "Voliner, Russia," in the Ukraine, like Morris?) She came to the U.S. in 1911 (as did all the Garfinkel children except Irving), lived on Bergen St. in Brooklyn, and was widowed by 1920. 1926 death certificate lists her as Rebecca Garfinkel, final residence at 1924 74th St., Brooklyn, New York, Father: David Samuels, born Russia, Mother, Ida Pichenick, born Russia.

Notes for Benjamin (Beryl) Garfinkel:

Benjamin (Beryl) immigrated on the S.S. Finland, sailing from Antwerp, on Feb. 17, 1906, arriving New York, Feb. 27, 1906. Beryl died before 1920.

Benjamin (Beryl) Garfinkel and Rebecca (Breindel) Samuels had the following children:

 IRVING BARNEY<sup>4</sup> GARFINKEL was born on 04 Mar 1896 in Vilna, Russia. He died in Jun 1963.

Notes for Irving Barney Garfinkel:

Not married. To U.S. June 1907. Got citizenship 1918. 1920 census shows he was the proprietor of a linoleum company.

- 9. ii. WILLIAM GARFINKEL was born on 15 Mar 1897 in Vilna, Russia. He died on 20 Sep 1988. He married Anna.
- 10. iii. SYLVIA GARFINKEL was born on 07 Sep 1900 in Vilna, Russia. She died in Feb 1978 in Florida. She married David Malkind on 26 Jan 1922 in Brooklyn, New York. He was born on 13 May 1898 in Trenton, New Jersey. He died on 02 Aug 1994 in Stony Brook, New York.
  - iv. Belle Garfinkel was born in 1905 in Vilna, Russia. She died on 20 Jan 1997 in Sherman Oaks, California. She married (1) Allan Taub in 1928 in New York. She married (2) Harry Krupnick in 1940. He was born in 1912 in Hudson, New York. He died in 1999.

Notes for Belle Garfinkel:

The 1911 ship manifest lists her as Beilash Garfinkel. Belle lived in Sherman Oaks, California, since 1952. No children. Born in Russia, came to U.S. in 1911 at age 6 (8, according to the ship manifest). 1920 census lists her as Bella, age 15, working at a clerical job with a newspaper. She attended NYU in New York. 1930's worked at Stammer's landmark bookstore in Manhattan, as rare book finder for prominent writers such as Theodore Dreiser and Sherwood Anderson. Belle helped organize a World Congress Against War & Fascism in Paris in 1935. Sherwood Anderson and Belle headed American delegation, and both were invited to tea at White House with Eleanor Roosevelt. Active in community service in Hudson, N.Y., where she served four terms as president of Hadassah. In Sherman Oaks, served as program chair of Community Concerts Association of the San Francisco Valley, and charter member of Los Angeles Valley College Patrons Association.

Notes for Allan Taub: No children.

v. Joseph Garfinkel was born in 1906 in Vilna, Russia. He died in Mar 1979. He married Shirley Kroll.

Notes for Joseph Garfinkel:

1911 ship manifest lists him as Josef Garfinkel. No children. 1920 census shows he was 14.

4. **PEARL**<sup>3</sup> **SAMUELS** (David<sup>2</sup> Shmykis, Isaac<sup>1</sup> Shmykis) was born in 1885 in Annopol, Russia (Ukraine). She died on 03 Sep 1956 in Bronx, New York. She married (1) ?. She married (2) **DAVID GARFINKLE**. He died on 1938 or 1939.

Notes for Pearl Samuels:

Pearl lived in Massachusetts and the Bronx, New York. She immigrated to the U.S. on the S.S. Berengaria, sailing from Southampton on Sept. 10, 1921, arriving New York, Sept. 18, 1921. Last permanent address abroad was Annopol, nearest relative Uncle, Same Sruyakas (presumably Smyskas), Gov. Wosja. Destination Chelsea Mass., to husband David Gurfrukiel, 85 Third St. Chelsea, Mass. with children Bnufla, 13, and Moishe, 12.

Notes for ?:

Russian.

Notes for David Garfinkle:

Miriam Lottner (Marci Garfinkle) says that David's gravestone spells his name Garfinkel. He was a rabbi on the Lower East Side in New York. He was quite a bit older than Pearl, and died in 1938 or 1939. He immigrated to the U.S. sailing from Trieste, May 29, 1909, arriving New York, June 15, 1909. He was from Bystryern, nearest relative, wife, Perel Garfunkel, Bystryern, Wolin, to Boston, Mass, Brother in law M. Samules in Bosotn, Mass. Two friends traveling with Dave were from the same town of Bystryern, to stay with "friend Sch.(?) Samauels?" at the same address.

David Garfinkle and Pearl Samuels had the following children:

- i. BERTHA<sup>4</sup> GARFINKLE was born in 1907 in Annopol, Russia (Ukraine). She died on 09 Jul 2005 in Sullivan, New York. She married Albert Snyder on 06 Nov 1932 in New York, NY. He was born on 09 Feb 1902 in Brooklyn, NY.
- 12. ii. MORRIS (MURRAY) GARFINKLE was born in 1909 in Annopol, Russia (Ukraine). He died in 1969. He married GUSSIE GOODMAN. She died in 1959.
- MORRIS<sup>3</sup> SAMUELS (David<sup>2</sup> Shmykis, Isaac<sup>1</sup> Shmykis) was born on 01 Jul 1885 in Annopol, Russia (Ukraine). He died on 02 Dec 1940 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. He married FANNIE SHALTUPSKY. She was born in 1892 in Grodno, Russia. She died in May 1973 in St. Louis, Missouri.

Notes for Morris Samuels:

1920 census states Morris had lived in Voliner, Russia. Lived in St. Louis, then Cape Girardeau. Lived for a while in San Antonio, Texas, in 1921. Owned retail store.

Naturalized Sept. 14, 1923, in Missouri: came to U.S. on the Lexeperia, from Liverpool, arrived in Boston March 10, 1902.

Notes for Fannie Shaltupsky:

Fannie came to U.S. 1907.

#### Notes for Samuel Samuels:

Sam's Hebrew name was Yeshiah Bar David (as seen on his gravestone), "Sheikie." He sometimes went by the name Charles (as listed in the 1920 census). He was orthodox, but more lax for his children. Neysa says that he would leave money on the table before Shabat, so the children would be able to have it.

# Notes for Mary Goldberg:

Lived at 5823 Webster St., Philadelphia, Pa. in 1957.

## Notes for William Samuels:

William was born Wolf (Zev) Shmykis. He had a twin sister who did not come to this country. William attended a private Hebrew school. The family business dealt in wheat, buying from peasants and selling in other parts of the country. It cost about 50 rubles (\$25) to pay the border guard to leave Russia in 1912, at age 16 or 17. He stayed in Germany, France, England, and other countries sometimes 4-5 days before passing the next border. (He describes two sisters and one brother as living in the U.S. before he came.)

William arrived in Halifax from Liverpool on board the S.S. Corsican on Feb. 10, 1913, and came to St. Louis via Montreal and Detroit. In the U.S., he worked for Curlee Clothing Co. in St. Louis. He wanted to go back to Russia when he reached age 21, so his mother would not be fined \$300 for his failure to report to the army, but he wasn't able to afford passage. Around 1920 he moved to Cape Girardeau. He worked 22 years in ladies' ready to wear, running one of two stores with his brother, Morris. He was naturalized on Sept. 22, 1925, in the Circuit Court of Cape Girardeau County at Jackson, Missouri (cert. no. 1618200).

He moved to Paragould, Arkansas, in 1938, where he co-owned and ran Samuels Hide and Metal Company and United Tin Compress. His citizenship papers say he was born Aug 15, 1894, but his tombstone says Sept. 25, 1895.

Notes for Fannie Sorkin:

Fannie came to the U.S. with the remaining Sorkin children, arriving at Ellis Island from Liverpool on the S.S. Campania on December 23, 1911. She earned \$6 per week at home, running a "butcher shop." The ship manifest lists her as "Feige," age17 (i.e., born 1894), working as a seamstress.

Her petition for naturalization was granted May 4, 1942, in Jonesboro, Arkansas: It lists her name as "Fanny," living at 600 S. Ninth St., Paragould, born in Moleskovitch, Russia on July 25, 1894. She was married on Dec. 25, 1916, Her citizenship papers say she was born Jul 25, 1894, but her tombstone says July 26, 1897. When Fannie lived in an assisted living facility in St. Louis, Ed was pushing her in her wheelchair from her room to the dining hall. It was a long ride. Fannie said, "It's like walking to Svershin."

- ii. BERNARD SAMUELS was born on 24 Nov 1918 in St. Louis, Missouri. He died on 26 Mar 2012 in Silver Spring, Maryland. ii. MARVIN GARFINKEL. He died on 07 Mar 2008 in Boynton Beach, FL. He married Norma Heller on 10 Nov 1963.
